The candidate will use various modes of liquid chromatography (RP-HPLC, SEC, IEC, HIC) as well as electrophoretic assays such as cIEF and CE-SDS for their analysis. Where appropriate, the candidate will perform MS based analysis or oversee MS analysis from third parties.

- BS, MS, or PhD in chemistry, analytical chemistry or other relevant disciplines.
- At least 5 years (MS, BS) or at least 2 years of experience (PhD).
- Experience with UPLC /HPLC required.
- Experience with capillary electrophoresis and CE-SDS preferred.
